Monday, June 26th to Friday, August 18th Monday - Friday 9:00 am to 3:00 pm

The Summer Festival is an outdoor recreation program held at Hopewell Park for children ages 5-12. Children enjoy swimming at Hopewell Pool, arts & crafts, sports, games, fun activities & a weekly field trip. They grow friendships, try new activities and embrace every moment of summer! Breakfast & Lunch are served by the Taunton School Department as part of the Summer Food Program offered by the USDA. In the event of rain, the program is held inside the former Coyle & Cassidy Gym. Registration is limited to 100 children per week. All children must be at least 5 years old by June 1, 2023 but no older than 12 to participate. There is a \$150 fee per week to participate in this recreation program and this includes all special events, trips & activities. There is an additional fee if enrolling in extended hours. Non-resident fee after June 1st (if space allows) is \$175 per week.

Extended Hours are available each day before and after the Summer Festival. Morning Care (6:45 - 8:30 am) is an additional \$30 per week. After Care (3:30 pm - 5:15 pm) is an additional \$35 per week. Both Morning & After Care are \$40 per week.

Scholarships Available 50 Scholarships Available Each Week

Through a Community Development Block Grant, scholarship money is available to be used towards Summer Festival 2023. Eligible Taunton families may apply for a scholarship and attend Summer Festival for the reduced rate of \$75 per week as space allows. Applications will be available for up to two (2) weeks* of Summer Festival per child at this reduced rate. Each scholarship is good to use toward the regular program hours of 9 am - 3 pm and do not include any extended care options (which are available at the regular rate).

All children under the age of 3 MUST wear a DISPOSABLE SWIM DIAPER in the wading pool - no exceptions..

Pre-Registration is required for any organized group of 10 or more (youth or adult) participating during Open Swim, each group must have a staff ratio of 1 adult (18 years of age or older) for every 6 participants. Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

Pre-Registration must be called in to the office 1 week prior to visit. A registration fee of \$50 will be charged for each visit.

The 3,200 sq. ft. SPLASH PAD at Hopewell Park is a refreshing place to cool off in the heat. It features motion and push-button activated jets of water shooting in different directions. This familyfriendly Splash Pad is the perfect place to cool down. Open daily 9:00 am to dusk, June 13th to September 6th.

Swimming Lessons ... Monday & Wednesday Evenings 5:30 pm - 6:10 pm **Wednesday & Friday Mornings** 10:45 am - 11:20 am

Instructors certified in American Red Cross water safety teach swim lessons at Hopewell Pool to children at least 5 years of age by June 1, 2023 (birth certificate may be required). Lessons will be held twice a week for five weeks, beginning the week of July 10th. Registration fee is \$40.

Non-resident swim lessons will be available after June 15th if space allows. Fee is \$50 per swimmer.

Tiny Tot Swim ... **Monday & Wednesday Evenings** 5:30 pm - 6:10 pm

Tiny Tot Swim allows children to become comfortable in the water as they learn basic water adjustment. Swim time is offered for parents and children under 5 years of age. This program is limited to Taunton residents only, and there must be one adult for each registered child. Tiny Tot Swim begins on Monday, July 10th and runs for five weeks. Registration fee is \$40.
